

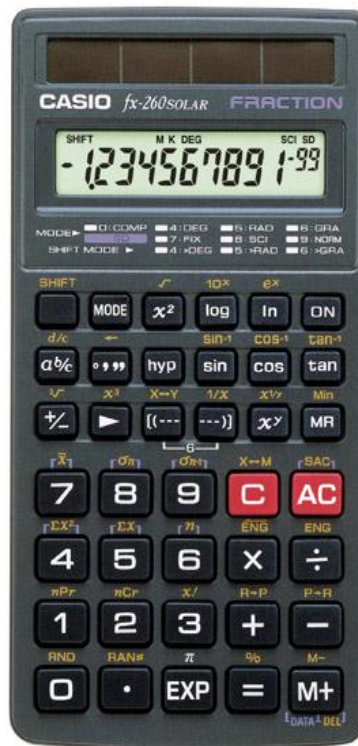

### Casio FX-260

The calculator **used for most trades** is the solar-powered Casio FX-260 scientific model, as shown below. The FX-260 provides basic and scientific functions required for most trade exams.

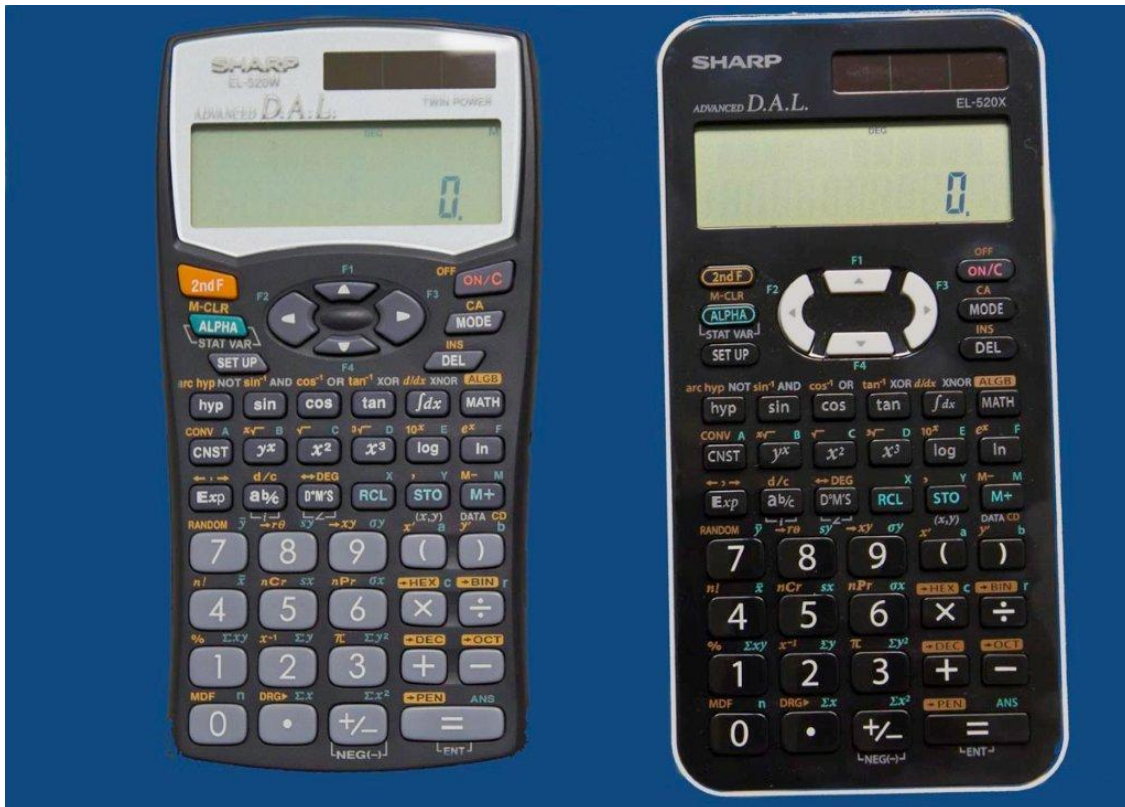

### Sharp EL-520

The Sharp EL-520 calculator is optional for **only the following trades**: **Communication Technician, Electrician, Instrument Technician, Machinist, Millwright, Powerline Technician and Power Systems Technician**. This calculator may be preferred by candidates for exams with higher-level mathematical content involving complex numbers and advanced polar or rectangular functions.

This calculator is available in one of two models – EL-520W or EL520X. Both models are functionally identical, with only minor differences in physical appearance.
