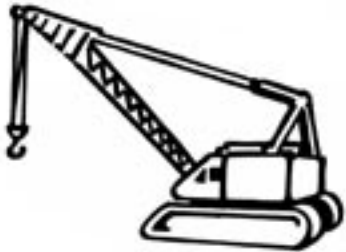

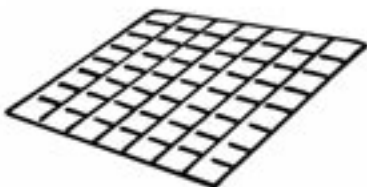

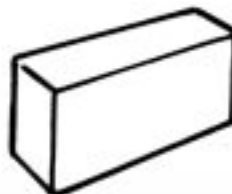

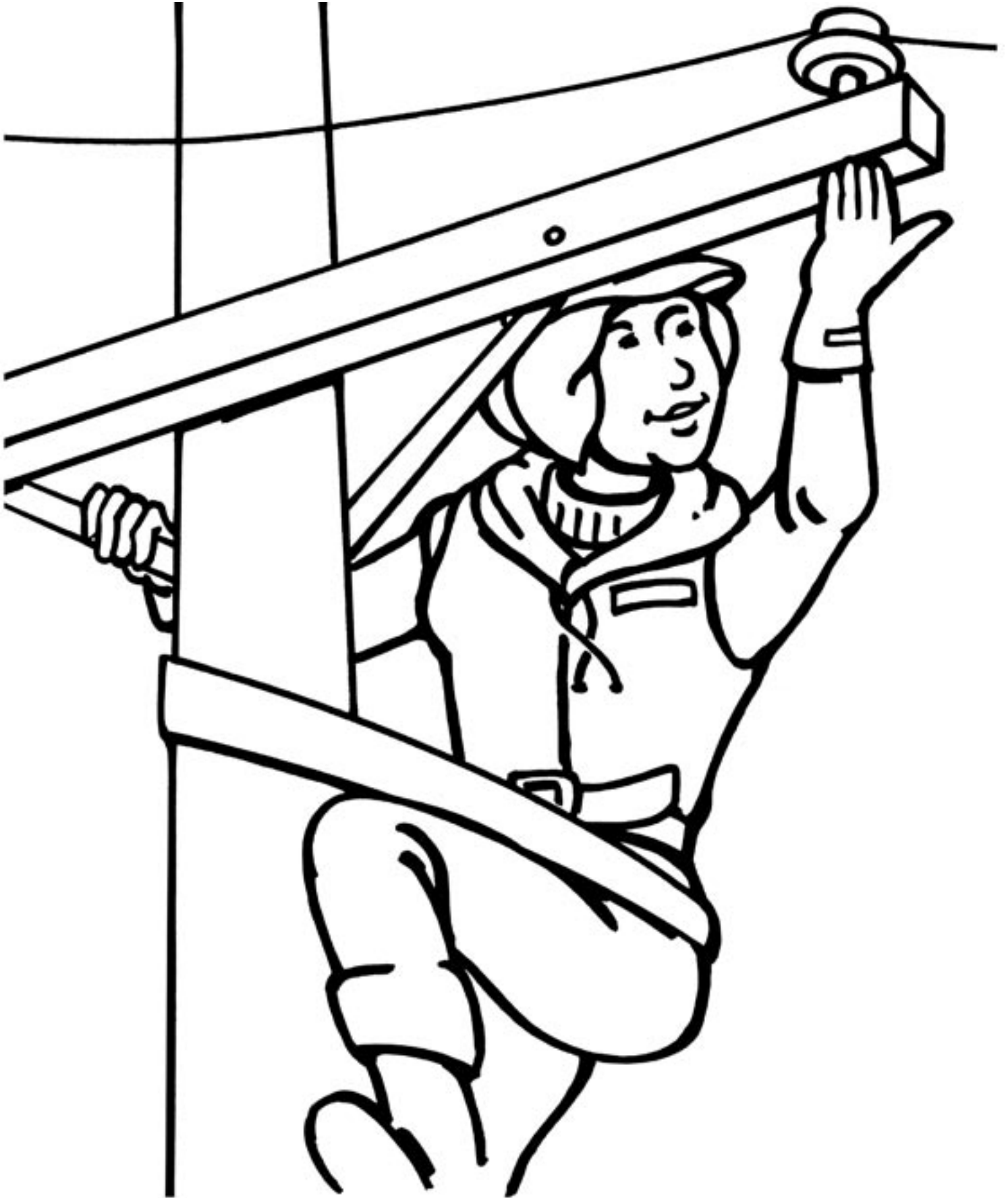

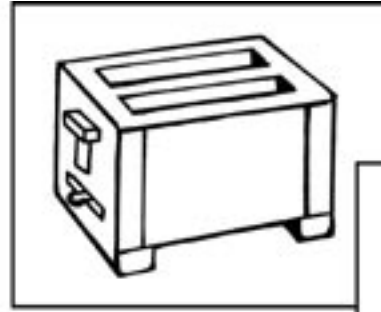
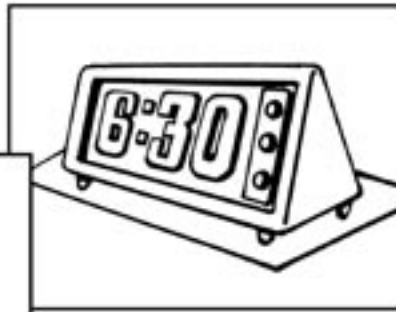
Electrical Trades

Draw a line from each one of the electrical objects showing which daily activity it helps.

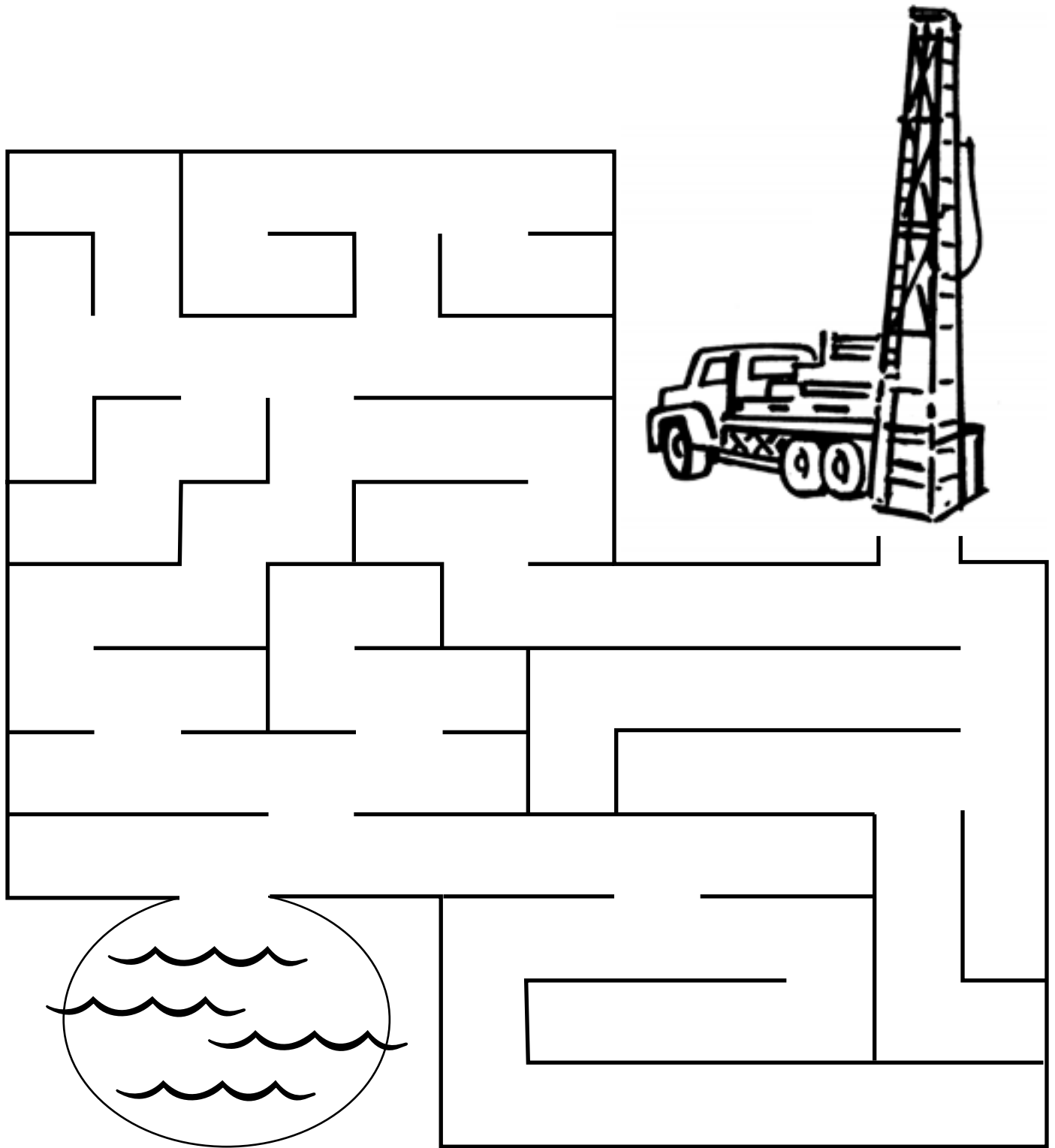


Industrial Trades

Start at the truck and find the path to the water.



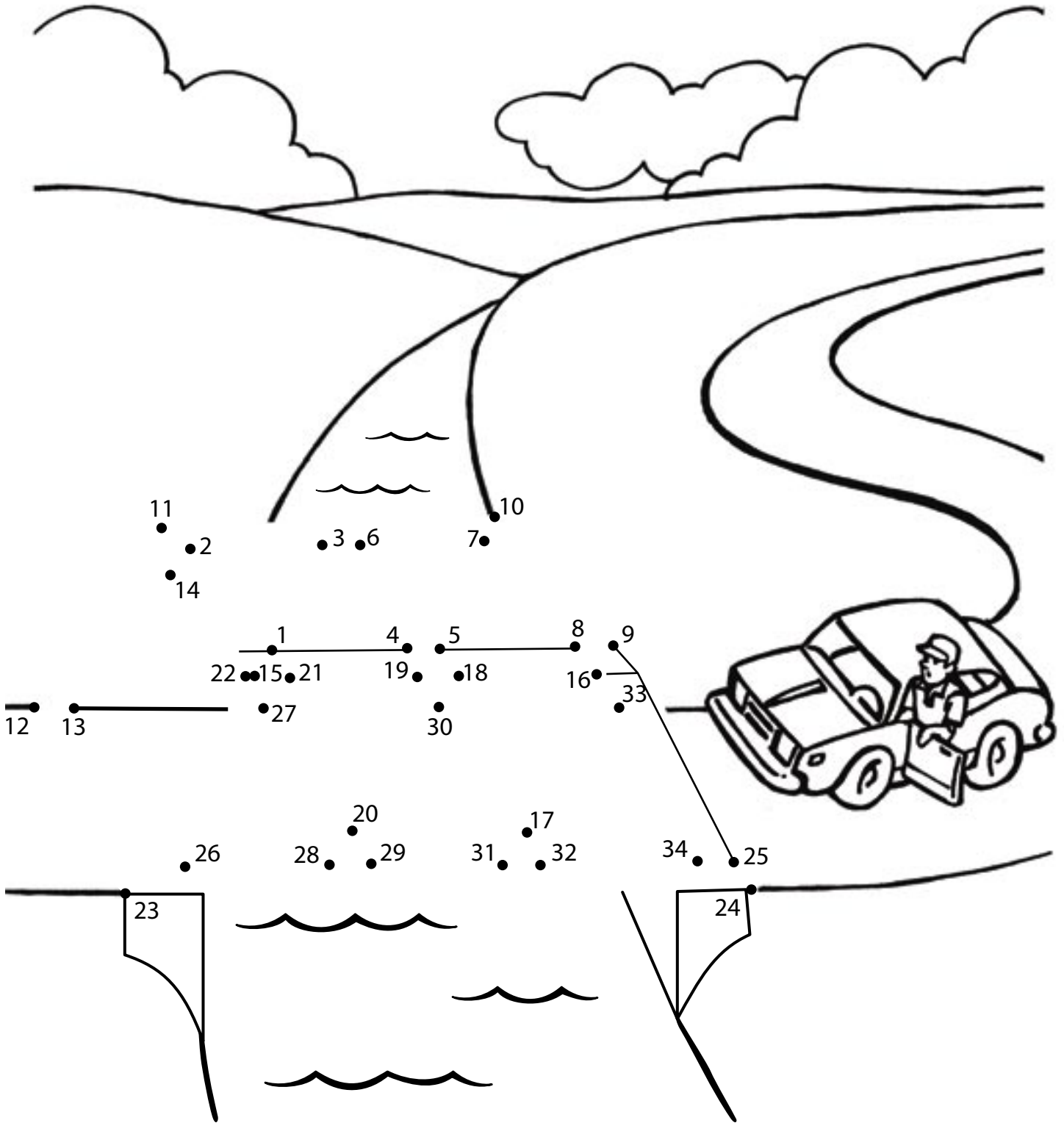
Metal Trades



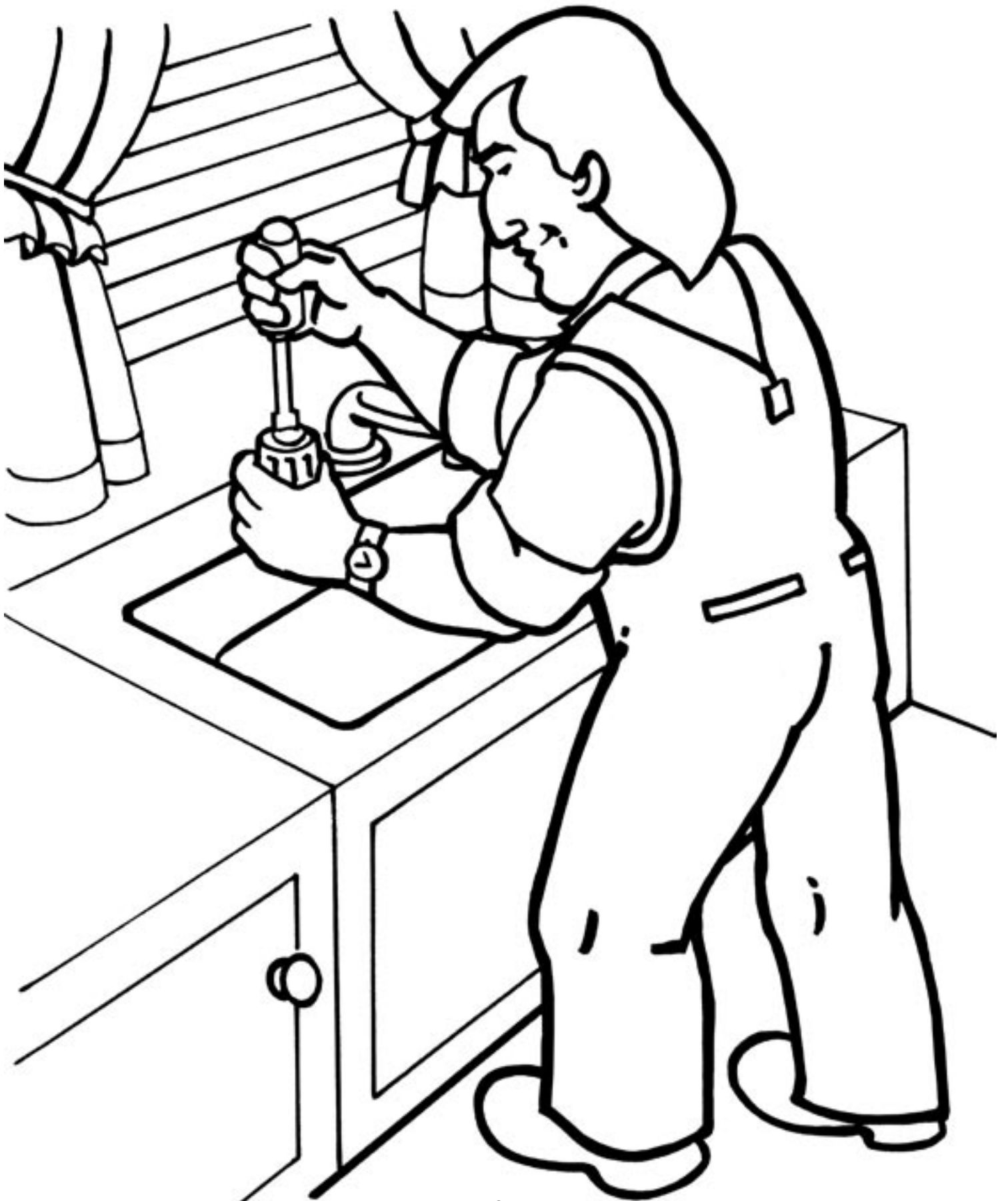
Metal Dot to Dot

Follow the numbers dot to dot to help this car cross the river.



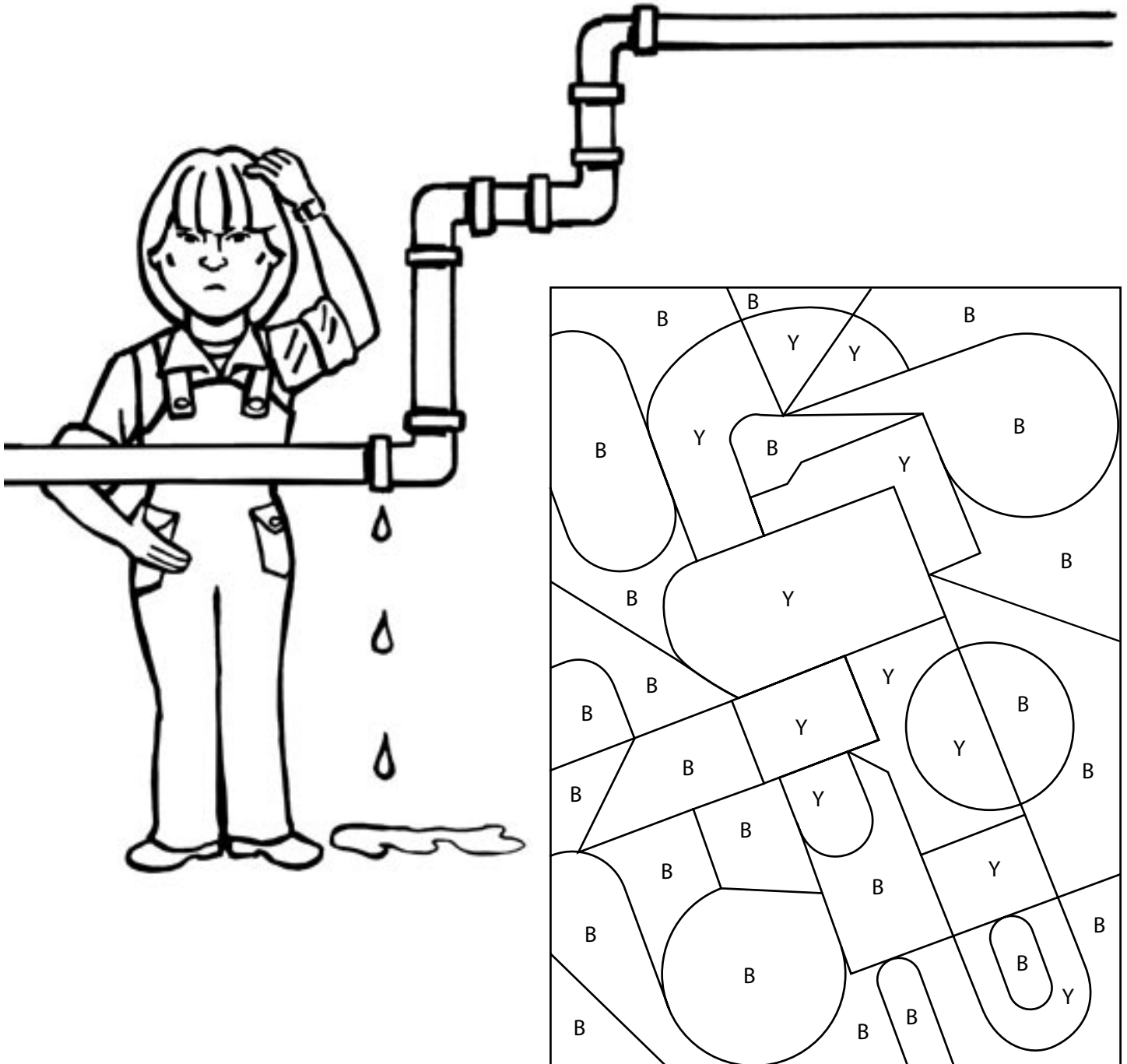
Piping Trades

Colour the areas marked with a "B" blue, and colour the areas marked with a "Y" yellow.

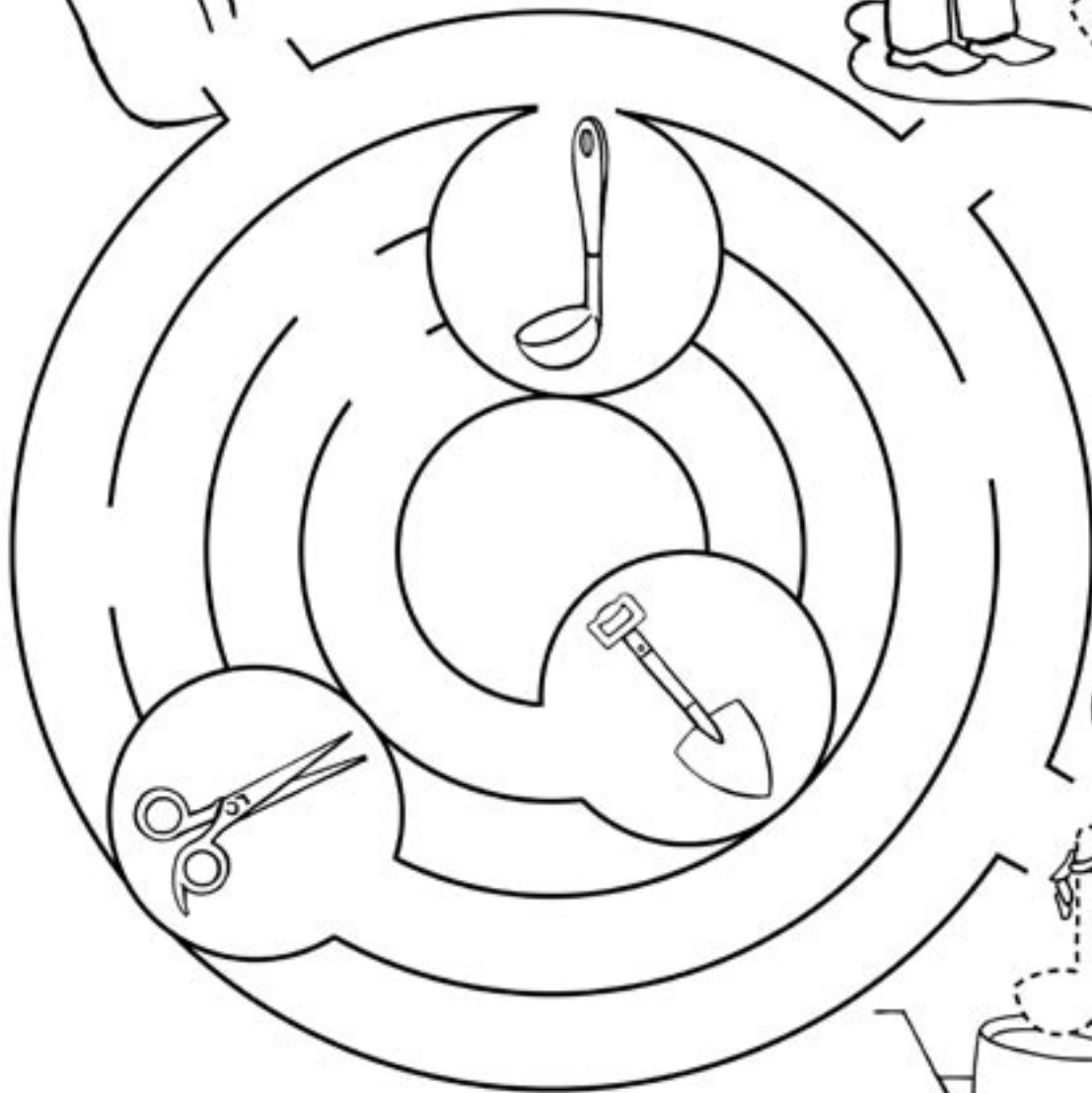

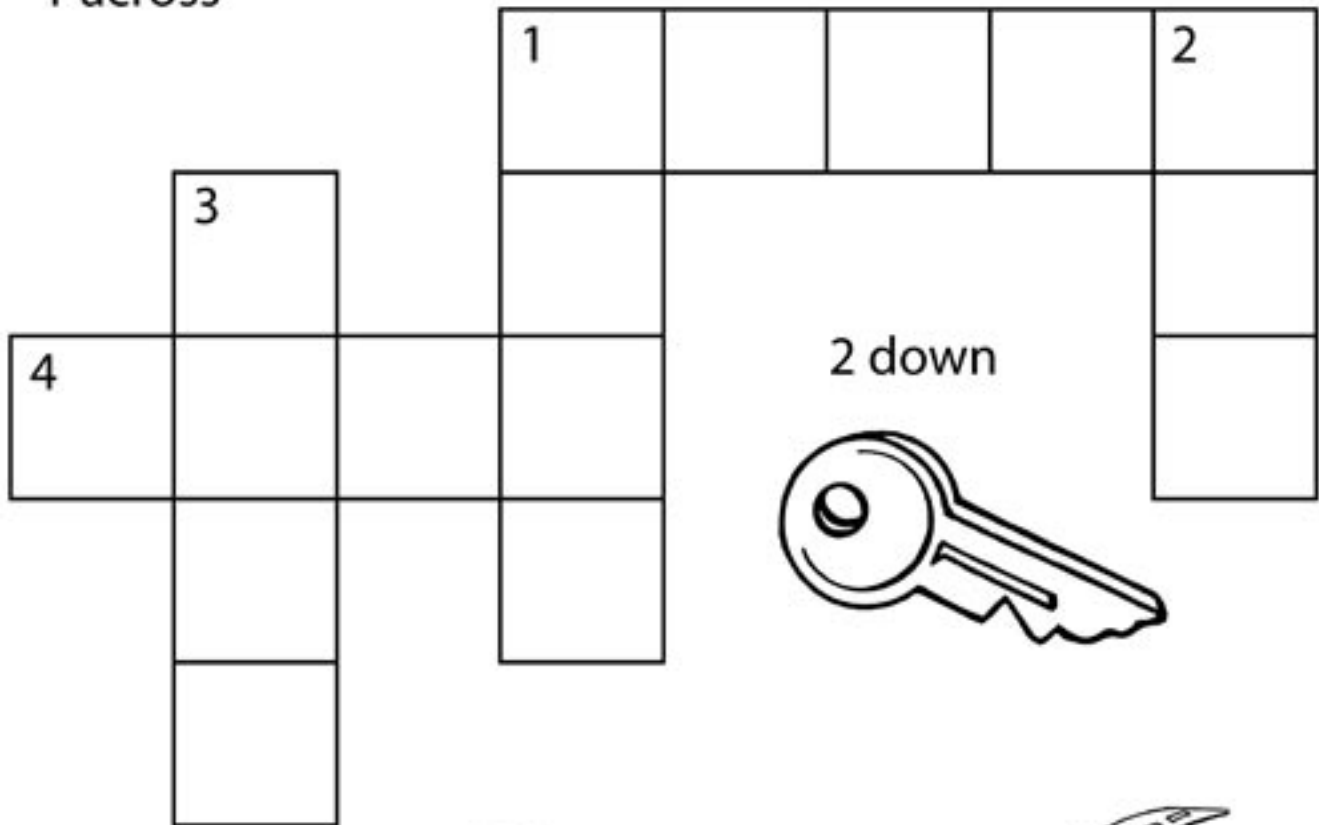
